

CrossRoads Festival Guidelines:

General:

A parent, guardian, youth minister or chaperone [21 years or older] MUST accompany all minors. Minors attending without a parent must have a waiver signed by a parent or guardian.

ABSOLUTELY NO alcohol, illegal drugs, fireworks or weapons are allowed on the grounds. Violators will be removed from the festival without a refund and may face criminal charges.

No pets allowed (except registered canines utilized to assist with a handicap); No solicitation or distribution of information will be allowed without prior approval. No smoking allowed in the concert areas and smoking by minors is prohibited.

No immodest clothing [swimsuits, tank tops, etc.] No clothing with offensive writing, logos or emblems allowed. Please refrain from the use of profanity or other offensive language.

Sunshades and beach umbrellas are allowed in the perimeter of the festival area only. Please be courteous and do not obstruct the view of others.

Children must be supervised at all times.

No glass containers allowed in the stage area. No littering. We are guests at Eagle Hurst.

Please be considerate and charitable with others. We are here to spend time with the Lord and our brothers and sisters in Christ.

Camping Rules:

Camping is divided into "His" and "Hers" areas. There will be no admittance of girls to the guy's campground or vice versa after dark. Please observe this simple rule!

Organizers reserve the right to assign or reassign campsites. There is camping in designated areas ONLY. Open pit fires of any kind are not allowed.

Each person at the campsite must be a registered festival attendee.

Please maintain "Quiet Time" between midnight and 6 AM. Be considerate of your neighbors.

The organizers reserve the right to refuse admission or eject any person violating the guidelines, local, state, or federal laws or whose conduct is deemed illegal, disorderly, or offensive.

Festival attendees may potentially have their image and/or likeness reproduced for promotional and/or publicity purposes, in event photography and/or web casts by festival organizers, contractors or partners of the festival.

Performers, programs and times are subject to change without notice. No refunds or exchanges including, but not limited to, failure of performer(s) to appear, changes in schedule or performer(s), or cancellation due to inclement weather, natural disaster or any other caused deemed reasonable by the festival organizers.
